Thank you for your continued interest in Mondelez International. Regarding your questions:

We generally do not provide detailed information on country-specific profitability across our global operations. As communicated previously, we have stood up our local business to operate more independently. We have discontinued new capital investments and advertising. Products sold in Russia are now produced and distributed locally, with no imports of finished goods from Europe into Russia or exports from Russia into Europe. The company continues to monitor the situation closely as we make Russia operations standalone.

Dear Mr. Van de Put and Mondelēz Leadership Team,

We write to you as [B4Ukraine](#), a coalition of Ukrainian and international civil society organizations working to curtail the financial resources enabling the Russian invasion of Ukraine.

We have written to you previously regarding [Mondelēz's](#) ongoing operations in Russia. We have received brief responses from Mondelēz, however none have answered the concerns and questions raised in our letters. The latest communication can be found [here](#).

B4Ukraine, in collaboration with the Kyiv School of Economics, is planning to publish a report containing information regarding company financial contributions in Russia since the full-scale invasion, including those of Mondelez. We are writing to formally enquire about the following statements and questions:

- **According to the analysis by the Kyiv School of Economics based on the Federal Tax Service of Russia, Mondelēz is one of a handful of companies which has not published information regarding its profit tax contribution in Russia in 2023. Mondelēz paid \$62 million in profit tax in Russia in 2022.**
- **Estimated data from the Kyiv School of Economics, based on the 2022 company filings with the Federal Tax Service of Russia, indicates that Mondelēz is among the highest contributors of profit taxes in Russia in 2023.**
- **What was the company's total revenue in Russia for the year 2023? What was the total amount of profit tax and other taxes the company paid in Russia in 2023?**

We would appreciate it if you could confirm the accuracy of this information or provide corrections if necessary, along with any supporting documents. Additionally, we would welcome any context or comments Mondelēz wishes to provide regarding these figures and its operations in Russia.

B4Ukraine maintains high standards of information verification before publishing. We are providing you with an opportunity to respond concerning the facts we wish to present. We will be awaiting a response from you by **August 29, 2024**. If we don't receive a response from you, we will indicate this in our publication.
